# Actual Gas Sales Volume in March 2002 and FY2001

#### Actual Gas sales volume in March 2002

Total gas sales volume by Tokyo Gas Co., Ltd., for the month of March 2002 came to about 867.4 million m<sup>3</sup>, down 16.8 million m<sup>3</sup> (or 1.9%) from March 2001. In the residential sector, volume totaled about 331.5 million m<sup>3</sup>, down 12.0% from March 2001. This decrease was due to higher than normal temperatures recorded in February and March. In the business sector (consisting of commercial, public, and medical use), volume amounted to about 187.5 million m<sup>3</sup>, down 7.9% from March 2001. This reduction derived from decreased demand for air conditioning caused by higher temperatures than last year. In the industrial sector, volume totaled 263.6 million m<sup>3</sup>, up 18.7% from the previous March, due to the addition of new customers. Volume for wholesale totaled about 84.7 million m<sup>3</sup>, up 3.6% from March 2001, due to the addition of a new buyer.

#### Gas sales volume in FY 2001

In FY 2001 (from 1 April 2001 to 31 March 2001), gas sales totaled 9,218.978 million m3, up 3.9% from FY 2000. In the residential sector, sales volume came to about 3,072.583 million m3, down 1.5% from FY 2000, due to high temperatures around the start of the fiscal year and at the end of the rainy season (from late spring to early summer), and the influence of this past mildest second winter on record. In the business sector, sales hit about 2,283.839 million m3, up 0.2% from FY 2000, due to the acquisition of new customers, despite of the negative impact influence of higher temperatures than last year. In the industrial sector, the volume reached about 2,911.602 million m3, up about 14.7% from FY 2000, due to the start of operation of new customer facilities. Wholesale supply (to other gas companies) came

to roughly 950.953 million m3, up 1.9% from FY 2000, due to factors such as an increase in the volume of transactions with the buyers.
