The Largest Daily Gas Supply volume record on January 8, 2004 Tokyo Gas Co., Ltd.

Daily gas supply volume on January 8, 2004 was 43.12 million cubic meters, which has become our new record. The largest daily supply volume record in the past was 42.74 million cubic meters on January 23, 2003.

Although the weather in Tokyo was rather mild from the beginning of this year, the average temperature on Jan. 8 was 5.7 degrees centigrade, which is the lowest in this winter so far. This record was mainly due to increased demand for city gas with added consumption by new customers in industrial and business sectors.
