## The Largest Daily Gas Supply volume record on January 14, 2004

Tokyo Gas Co., Ltd.

Daily gas supply volume on January 14, 2004 was 44.07 million cubic meters, which has become our new record. The largest daily supply volume record in the past was 43.12 million cubic meters on January 8, 2004.

As the average temperature on January 14, 2004 was lower than January 8, 2004, demand in hot water and heating was quite strong. In addition, increased demand for city gas with added consumption by new customers in both industrial and business sectors also contributed to the new record.
