The Largest Daily Gas Supply volume record on January 10, 2006

Tokyo Gas Co., Ltd.

Daily gas supply volume on January 10, 2006 was 49.01 million cubic meters, which has broken the past record (48.57 million cubic meters on December 19, 2005) and has become our new record.

As the temperature was low throughout the day, demand for both hot water and heating was very strong. In addition, the base demand was increased with acquisition of new customers in both industrial and business sectors, which also contributed to the new record.
