## The Largest Daily Gas Supply Volume record on January 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2008 Tokyo Gas Co., Ltd.

Daily gas supply volume on January 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2008 was 56.88 million cubic meters, which has broken the past record (55.17 million cubic meters on January 18, 2008) and has become our new record.

As it has been snowing and the average temperature of January 23<sup>rd</sup> was 3.0 degrees Celsius which is 2.5 degrees below than the average year, demand for heating and hot water was very strong. In addition, the base demand was increased with acquisition of new customers in both industrial and business sectors, and the number of customers exceeded over 10 million last September, which also contributed to the new record.
