## The Largest Daily Gas Supply Volume record on January 16th, 2013

Tokyo Gas Co., Ltd.

Daily gas supply volume of Tokyo Gas (President: Mr. Tsuyoshi Okamoto) on Wednesday, January 16th, 2013 was 57.29 million cubic meters, which has broken the past record (56.88 million cubic meters on Wednesday, January 23rd, 2008) for the first time in last 5 years and has become our new record.

As the weather on Wednesday, January 16th was cloudy, fine later and the average temperature of January 16th was 3.6 degrees Celsius, 2.5 degrees below the average year, the demand for heating water and space was increased. In addition, the largest daily gas supply was recorded due to the development of new demands following the commencement of new trunk lines and to the increased demand for power generation, etc.
