Tokyo Gas Co., Ltd. (President: Michiaki Hirose; hereinafter "Tokyo Gas") decided today to integrate Chiba Gas Co., Ltd. (President: Kenji Tsunoda; hereinafter "Chiba Gas"), Tsukuba Gakuen Gas Co., Ltd. (President: Tatsuaki Sakuta; hereinafter "Tsukuba Gakuen Gas") and Miho Gas Co., Ltd. (President: Hiromasa Tanaka; hereinafter "Miho Gas") into Tokyo Gas as of May 1, 2016.
