Receiving of Electricity from Moka Power Station

Tokyo Gas Co., Ltd. (President: Takashi Uchida, "Tokyo Gas") has started receiving electricity from the Moka Power Station ("this power station") owned by Kobelco Power Moka Inc. (President: Akihisa Fujio).

This power station is a natural gas-fired combined cycle power plant with a generating capacity of approximately 1.25 million kW (624,000 kW x 2 units). It is Japan's first large-scale inland power plant as a natural gas-fired power plant. The first unit of this power station has been completed, and Tokyo Gas receives electricity starting today.

Tokyo Gas supplies city gas to this power station through a high-pressure gas pipeline and receives all of the electricity generated during the first 15 years of operation.

In its medium-term business plan "GPS2020", Tokyo Gas has set a target of procuring 5 million kW of electric power in the 2020s. We will continue to contribute to the stable and efficient supply of energy.
